New Talk Outlines and Meditations

The International Secretariat voted to send the new finished rollo and meditation outlines to the communities for preview at the International Secretariat in meeting in Crockett, Texas on October 31, 2004..

The Secretariat anticipates that they will call for a Proxy Vote at the Assembly in July. The Proxy would be to approve the outlines as the official outlines for all of Tres Dias. It will be necessary to make appropriate changes in The Essentials for any outlines with new names. The approval will require a 2/3rds majority of the votes.

It is anticipated that there will be a period for conversion to the new outlines after they are accepted by Proxy Vote. With local Tres Dias community approval, a rollista could use either the old or the new outline during that period. The conversion period has not as yet been determined. After the conversion period, the new finished outlines would become the official outlines of Tres Dias per "The Essentials of Tres Dias".

The new finished outlines of the rollos and meditations are the ones prepared by the Blue Ribbon Committee with input solicited from all communities.

What We Do....

The Tres Dias Secretariat has a total of 27 voting members, seven of whom are officers: president, executive vice president, administration vice president, membership vice president, treasurer, financial secretary, and secretary. The purpose of the Secretariat is to conduct the year round business of TRES DIAS.

The Policy committee handles all matters in Pre-weekend, Weekend, Fourth Day, TD Essentials and proposes policy for the Tres Dias movement for consideration of the Secretariat and the Assembly.

The Services Committee produces/distributes the newsletter and other periodicals published by TRES DIAS. They print/manufacture and distribute any items written or generated by any committee of TRES DIAS. The committee may engage in sales of any item to local secretariats and in the sale of TRES DIAS unique items to any individual or group. They also maintain an archive of historically interesting and important data, which preserves the history of the Tres Dias movement and any Tres Dias unique material.

The Executive Committee deals with all matters concerning: legal planning, budget and financial planning, changes in the TRES DIAS organization, changes in the Constitution and By-Laws. The committee assists the president, where requested, in his/her duties. The treasurer and financial secretary of the Secretariat are members of this committee.

The Administration Committee makes all arrangements for Assembly sessions and Secretariat meetings. They propose to the Secretariat for approval a slate of nominees for officers and members of the Secretariat, and propose to the Secretariat for later Assembly approval modifications or additions to the qualifications for delegates to the Assembly

Membership Committee charters local secretariats, develop additional local Tres Dias communities, support Pescadores in geographic areas not covered by a local secretariat, and propose to the Secretariat for later Assembly approval additions or modifications to the qualification for chartering or rechartering of a local secretariat.
